## Boo Camp 2015 General Information

NM FolkMADS invites dancers and musicians to spend the Halloween weekend in the beautiful Jemez Mountains at Hummingbird Camp for dancing, singing and jamming. Dance (contras and more) to the music of **THE CHEAP SHOTS & THE VIRGINIA CREEPERS**, to dances called by **DEB COMLEY** and New Mexico Callers Collective. Camp starts with registration Friday at 4:30pm in the Greenhouse, potluck dinner on the patio at 6:30pm and dancing at 8pm. Camp ends after lunch Sunday.

This year our camp is being held on the **SOUTH CAMPUS**. The dance hall (*the Greenhouse*) is directly across from the dining hall.



LODGING OPTIONS: there are four options for lodging this year plus



camping. Due to limited number of all indoor options except the bunkhouse, please check with the registrar (Angela Welford, <u>awelford1017@gmail.com</u>) for availability of your choice.

**CABINS**: Newly remodeled motel-style rooms with en suite bath. Amenities include mini-fridg, coffee maker, linens and towels. 7 cabins available, 2 sleep 4 (double bed plus twin bunk), 5 sleep 2 (double bed or twins). No parking in front of cabins. Preference given to two (or more) people signing up together.

SEMI-PRIVATE: Two rooms, each with 2 twin beds, co-joined

by a bathroom. Amenities include sink in the room and chairs. Linens and towels not included. 4 rooms available on the ground floor in the Beehive Bunkhouse. Preference given to two people signing up together.

**PRIVATE**: One twin bed in a private room, share common bathroom. Linens and towels not included. Three rooms available, two are located in the Greenhouse





**BUNKHOUSE**: Two rooms, each with 11-12 bunk-beds and a few single beds, sharing common bathroom. One of the rooms has an alcove, allowing for some privacy (arrive parts to path that ereal) Note that one privacy

allowing for some privacy (arrive early to nab that area!) *Note that one-nighters can only be housed in the bunkhouse.* 

**CAMPING**: There are 4-6 walk-in tent sites along the river and a couple of shaded spots for RV type campers beyond the Beehive Bunkhouse. RV camping is also available just north of the Greenhouse. No hookups. Bathrooms/showers available in the Greenhouse (dance hall).
