Who Can Apply for this Funding

FolkMADS members who are:

- In need of scholarships to attend workshops, weekend events, conferences, festivals, etc., for one or more of these purposes:
 - To offer leadership training of callers, musicians, singers and event organizers
 - To encourage youth involvement
- Involved in related endeavors that will have a lasting effect on the our community.

Requirements

Recipients of FolkMADS grants are expected to:

- Be a member of FolkMADS
- Provide a follow-up report after the event/project including successes, challenges, or other feedback.

Amount of Funding

- Grants can fund up to \$400 per applicant per one-year period.
- Grants totaling \$1200 may be given in any fiscal (calendar) year.

How to Apply

Priority deadlines are semi-annually: **April 1** and **October 1**. Send all requested information on the application (pdf) via email to folkmads@gmail.com. Responses may take up to two months as decisions must be made by the FolkMADS board at a board meeting.
